GOA STATE DEVELOPMENT LOAN, 2012

It is notified for general information that the outstanding balance of 6.80% Goa State Development Loan, 2012 issued in terms of the Government of Goa, Finance Department Notification No.1-45-2002, Fin (Bud) dated December 16, 2002, will be repaid at par on December 22, 2012 (December 23, 2012 being Sunday) with interest due up to and including December 22, 2012. In the event of a holiday being declared on the aforesaid date by any State Government under the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, the loan will be repaid by the paying offices in that State on the

previous working day. No interest will accrue on the loan from and after December 23. 2012.

2. As per sub-regulation 24 (2) and 24 (3) of Government Securities Regulations, 2007 payment of maturity proceeds to the registered holder of Government Security held in the form of Subsidiary General Ledger or Constituent Subsidiary General Ledger account or Stock Certificate shall be made by a pay order incorporating the relevant particulars of his bank account or by credit to the account of the holder in any bank having facility of receipt of funds through electronic means. For the purpose of making payment in respect of the securities, the original subscriber or the subsequent holders of such a Government Securities, as the case may be, shall submit to the Bank or Treasury and Sub-Treasury or branch of State Bank of India, or its subsidiary banks where they are enfaced/registered for payment of interest, as the case may be, the relevant particulars of their bank account.

3. However, in the absence of relevant particulars of bank account/mandate for receipt of funds through electronic means, to facilitate repayment on the due date, holders of 6.80% Goa State Development Loan, 2012 should tender their securities at the Public Debt Office, 20 days in advance. The securities should be tendered for repayment, duly discharged on the reverse thereof as under:—

"Received the Principal due on the Certificate".

- 4. It should be particularly noted that at places where the treasury work is done by a branch of the State Bank of India or any of its associate banks, the securities, if they are in the form of Stock Certificates, should be tendered at the branch of the bank concerned and not at the Treasury or Sub-treasury.
- 5. Holders who wish to receive payment at places other than those where the securities have been enfaced for payment should send them duly discharged to the Public Debt Office concerned by Registered and Insured Post. The Public Debt Office will make payment by issuing a draft payable at any Treasury/Sub-Treasury or branch of State Bank of India or its associate banks conducting Government Treasury work in the State of Goa.

Sanction of the Government is hereby conveyed for the implementation/continuation of the sub-component "Motorization of Traditional Crafts" under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations" with the following revised Pattern of Assistance from the year 2012-13.

(a) Motorization (Out-Board Motors)//Financial Assistance for purchase of outboard motors for operation of fishing canoe.

The beneficiary will be entitled for financial assistance to the extent of 50% of the cost limited to Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) per O.B.M. of 8-10 HP to be shared by the State and the Central Government from the year 2012-13 of which the Central share shall be 50% of the eligible subsidy limited to Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) and balance of Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees forty five thousand only) shall be borne by the State Government with the following conditions:

- (a) The beneficiary should possess an own registered fishing canoe.
- (b) The beneficiary or any family member of his household should not be defaulter with the Directorate of Fisheries.
- (c) The OBM purchased through the scheme shall be incorporated on the registered fishing canoe.
- (d) The original VAT bill may be submitted by the beneficiary from authorized dealer to claim the subsidy.
- (e) The subsidy amount shall be disbursed in favour of the applicant in his/her account through ECS mode of payment.
- (f) The beneficiary will be entitled for grant of subsidy once every five years per family household.

- (g) The beneficiary shall not sell, lease, mortgage or transfer the Out-Board Motor for a period of five years from the date of purchase of the said OBM.
- (h) The Out-Board Motor purchased shall be operated exclusively for fishing purpose only.

The bank will finance the loan amount to the extent of the cost of the outboard motor hypothecating the canoe of the applicant and considering the cost of the canoe as margin money and also taking into account of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) as a Government subsidy. Motor purchased with self finance are also eligible for subsidy at the above rate.

The beneficiary will be entitled for subsidy to the extent of 50% of the actual cost limited to Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) for purchase of Gill Nets with accessories

through Bank finance or self finance with the following conditions:

- (a) The beneficiary should possess an own registered fishing canoe.
- (b) The beneficiary or any member of his household should not be defaulter with the Directorate of Fisheries.
- (c) The original VAT bill may be submitted by the beneficiary from authorized dealer to claim the subsidy.
- (d) The subsidy amount shall be disbursed in favour of the applicant in his/her account through ECS mode of payment.
- (e) The beneficiary will be entitled for grant of subsidy in every four years after availing first subsidy.

Sanction of the Government is hereby conveyed for the implementation of the scheme "Construction of Wooden/FRP Craft for traditional fishermen" under the following revised Pattern of Assistance from the year 2012-13.

The financial assistance in the form of subsidy shall be granted to the fishermen by the State Government for construction of fishing craft (wooden/FR plastic) of 26 feet to

36 feet financed by the Nationalized Banks//Financial Institutions or through self finance subject to the availability of funds during the respective year.

The traditional fishermen will be granted subsidy to the extent of 50% of the actual cost of the craft limited to Rs. 60,000/-(Rupees sixty thousand only) per craft with the following conditions.

- (a) The beneficiary should be traditional fishermen by birth or profession and should be resident of Goa.
- (b) The beneficiary or any member of his household should not be defaulter with the Directorate of Fisheries/Goa, Daman & Diu Fisheries Federation.
- (c) The beneficiary will be entitled for grant of subsidy once every four years on one craft per family household.
- (d) The original VAT bills may be submitted by the beneficiary from authorized boat building yard to claim the subsidy.
- (e) The subsidy amount shall be disbursed in favour of the applicant in his/her account through ECS mode of payment.
- (f) The canoe purchased through the scheme shall be duly registered with the Directorate of Fisheries under Goa, Daman & Diu Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980.
- (g) The wooden/FRP craft purchased shall be operated exclusively for fishing purpose only.
- (h) The beneficiary shall not sell, lease mortgage or transfer the wooden/FRP craft for a period of five years from the date of purchase of the said wooden/FRP craft.
